Presidents Report:

Well this meeting will mark the last meeting that we will hold at the field. This meeting is Wed. August 13, 2014 and will start at 6:00, due to the fact that it is getting darker early. Bring a plane and have some fun.

I have included a revision to the bylaws that was modified and reviewed by the board. The major and only revision to these bylaws is the separating of the Secretary/Treasurer function into two separate positions. This was done for a few reasons, but first I will give you some history as to why that transpired. First as you read the Secretary, as described in general Corporate Governance performs the functions described in the modifications, it also brings our bylaws in line with the other clubs bylaws in the Denver area. I was President of the club in 1990-1991. I took over that role after the club lost the lease on the property which was between Parker and Castle Rock. My first task was to find us a suitable field. I searched high and wide and finally found the property we are located on presently. I negotiated the lease after several meetings and testifying in front of the State Land Board, (I still have that transcript if you had a cassette tape player). In May 1991, I signed the final lease documents and commenced taking on the role of Corporate Registrar for Crosswinds RC. When Mark Hample took on the role of President, I assumed the role of Secretary and Treasurer, since I was performing both functions. Shortly thereafter the decision was made to merge the

officer classification as one and the position of Secretary/Treasurer was created as a matter of convenience. I held that position for 14 years. During this time I was the contact point of the club and worked to be placed on the Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) by a vote of the RAB Board, to represent the club on the Lowry Bombing Range. I still currently hold that position as there are no further appointments to that board, I will be attending the next meeting this month and attached you will find an agenda of that meeting. I have also continued the role of maintaining our lease in good standing with the State of Colorado Land Board and have had to smooth a few tenuous times when the State wanted to go a different direction, as well as the legal duties of corporate filings. I have basically been performing the functions as described in the revised bylaws because no one else wanted to do them. Currently we are going to start Negotiations on the lease I plan on commencing the negotiations on the lease this Fall/Early Winter. My term as president expires in December and since I have the historical relationship with the State Land Board and the acumen of the clubs legal affairs, I plan on continuing the duties as described. The board discussed this and as such we are presenting the modifications to the bylaws as attached. We need you to respond to Dan Cunningham in writing or email format daniel.cunningham2@comcast.net with your approval or disapproval. Please include your name and AMA number in the email.

Now it is August and our club does need nominations for officers. Please consider a role as a club officer, remember it is still your club and as such you should step up and volunteer.
