Business Meeting

The business portion of the meeting was called to order by Vice President, Frank Kaylor at 6:30 PM and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Frank welcomed back Dennis "Sparky" Kordes. Dennis has been sidelined for the past few weeks with health issues. Frank also recognized long-time member Stuart Carr for attending.

The minutes of the March 11 meeting were approved as they appeared in the newsletter. Motion by Wayne Perry. Second by Jack Steinhauser.

Vice President's Report

Frank Kaylor passed around a sign-up sheet for the Member Work Day scheduled for April 25. Work is scheduled to begin about 9:30 AM and hopefully finish up by 1:00 PM or so. Bring airplanes if you want to fly after work is completed.

Results of sign-up sheet:

Secretary/Treasurer's Report

Mike Noll reported the club currently has two accounts with First Bank in Castle Rock. The balance in the checking account is \$XXX, the balance in the Lease Security Deposit account is \$XXX. Income for the months of February and March was \$575 which included dues and initiation fees from four new members--Michael and Weston Rix, Ron Rose, Brad Barnum and Jeff Mudgett. Expenses included \$21.04 for name badges for new members, \$9.27 to digitize and scan the field survey, \$15,000 cash bond for our flying field lease, and \$64.95 for property taxes.

Members were reminded that dues will be due during the month of May and delinquent if not received prior to June 1. Mike Noll will bring Member Renewal Applications to the May meeting so that anybody there can fill out the renewal form and pay the dues. Members are reminded to bring their checkbooks or cash.

Member At Large Report

Dennis Kordes suggested the program for the May 13 meeting will be Show and Tell. Members are encouraged to bring in your favorite airplane to show and say why it's your favorite. Warbirds Over Parker

Wayne Perry passed around a flyer regarding the Warbirds Over Parker flying event being held at our flying field July 25 and 26. The flyer gives information regarding the event and also includes a map to the field. Wayne is the contest director. He said this will be an AMA sanctioned event and there might be 25 or so pilots and maybe 50 to 100 spectators attending. Spectators will be charged five dollars per carload as they enter the gate and additional grass mowing will be required in order to accommodate the increased parking. Each car will be given an entry ticket for a give-away of several donated airplanes. AeroWorks and Action Hobbies have agreed to provide prizes. Food service will be available. It has not been determined yet whether the club will provide the food or if it will be provided by a food vendor.

No further business being presented, a motion to adjourn was made by Jack Steinhauser; seconded by Norm Vanderslice and the meeting adjourned at 6:50 PM.

Program Portion of the Meeting

Frank Kaylor gave a demonstration of how to create aircraft trim decals. He showed how to convert patterns and designs retrieved from the Internet into trim pieces that can be applied to our airplane coverings. He took a standard star shaped pattern and demonstrated the various steps involved to transfer the pattern to the trim sheet, to cut out the pattern and how to apply it to a MonoKote surface.
